

Brathay Windermere Marathon 2007



- Windermere is England's largest lake
- The most scenic marathon route in the UK
- Anti-clockwise route passing through Hawkshead, Newby Bridge, Bowness-on Windermere and Ambleside
- Starting and finishing at Brathay Hall the route around Windermere is exactly 26.2 miles – the required distance for recognition as a full marathon course
- The Windermere Marathon was last held in October 2006
- Winning time in 1986 – 02'28"38
- Winning woman's time in 1986 – 03'02"52
- Men's record – 02'23"16 (Mike Critchley, Bolton 1985)
- Women's record – 2'25"08 (Lorna Irving, Border Harriers 1983)
